**Remember to let the office know about your spot for next year as soon as possible. Deposits are due by March 1 to hold your spot. We have a waiting list for next year already.**

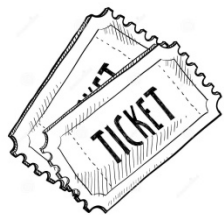

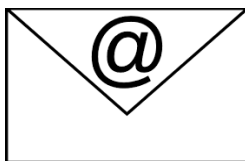
**DOGS:** Pick up after your dog and that's mandatory! Do not leave your dog tied outside.

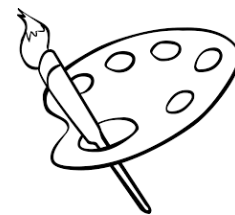

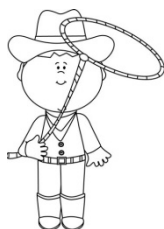
